DTR Architectural Specifier named CSI Fellow

SANTA ROSA, CA – John R. Guill, FCSI, RA, CCS, CCCA, AIA, SCIP of Santa Rosa, California, was just named a Fellow of the Construction Specifications Institute (CSI). Fellowship is among CSI’s most prestigious honors.

CSI is a national association of specifiers, architects, engineers, contractors, building materials suppliers and others involved in building trades, design and construction industries.

Although the organization has nearly 17,000 members, only a few hundred have been elevated to fellow since the Fellowship was introduced in the organization in 1959. Guill was one of eight new Fellows to be elevated this year. A public presentation will be held at the Construct™ and CSI Annual Convention later this year in Phoenix, September 14th at the Hyatt Regency Hotel.

Fellows are nominated by their colleagues and selected by CSI’s Jury of Fellows in recognition of their accomplishments in advancing construction technology, improving construction specifications, educating people in the construction industry, or advancing the goals of the Institute. Guill has also been recognized recently receiving the “Wilbur Johnston Memorial Award” in April this year and “Ben John Small Memorial Award” in May 2010, along with other local chapter and regional awards.

Guill is an Associate in the Firm with DTR Consulting Services, Inc. a national specification and building envelope consulting firm. He currently leads DTR’s northern California specification writers and quality assurance team. Guill has also led numerous national webinars on technical design practices in addition to numerous speaking engagements

He is a Registered Architect (RA), a member of the American Institute of Architects (AIA) and Specification Consultants in Independent Practice (SCIP). Guill has been a member of CSI since 1996.
